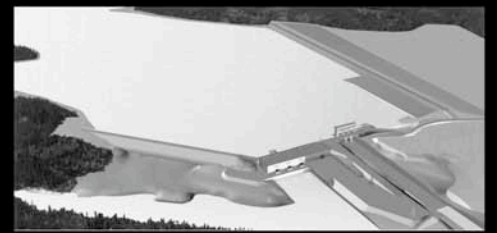

Journeyman Plumber (BNA APPENDIX 14)



RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assembles, Installs and repairs pipes, fixtures and fittings used for water distribution and waste disposal in private, public and industrial buildings, according to local plumbing codes
- Examines building plans and specifications to determine the layout for plumbing system components such as water supply network, sewage waste drainage and plumbing fixtures
- Locates positions and cuts openings for pipe connections, passage holes and fixtures in walls and floors
- Measures, cuts, and threads pipes using hand and power tools
- Joins pipes using couplings, clamps, screws, bolts, cement or soldering, brazing and welding equipment
- Tests pipes for leaks using air and water pressure gauges

QUALIFICATION / EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Must have Certificate of Qualification
- Additional experience at the Journeyman level may be required for some positions
- Must be required to supply basic tools of the trade
