Our inherent right to govern ourselves was never taken away at the time we signed the Adhesion to Treaty 5 in 1908.

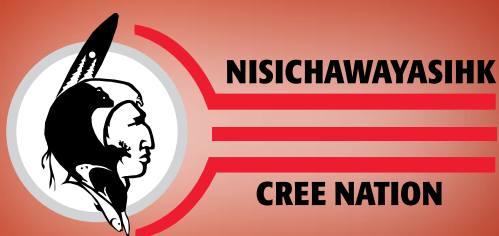
NCN has undertaken steps at various times over the past few decades to restore and rebuild our governance systems based on our inherent rights. Entering into a Self-Government Agreement (SGA) is an important next step towards reconciliation between our pre-existing sovereignty and Canada's assertions of its sovereignty.

An NCN SGA will allow the community to establish more sustainable programs, services and benefits for our citizens based on our culture, our history and our needs.
