**Other government rules include:**

**Declaration Common Law Unions** – two people in a relationship and co-habiting who falsely declare single, can be disqualified, which could result in a clawback. It is important that individuals declare the status of their relationship.)

**Child Out of Parental Home (COPH)** – If parents have children residing out of the home and are working and making an income, they must give and declare child support to the guardian or caregiver of their children. For example, if a person receiving income assistance is caring for their grandchildren or nieces/nephews, a working biological parent is generally required to support the children so the caregiver could lose benefits.

**Ensure that all newborns are registered** for Treaty Status cards.

The NCN Administration and Income Assistance staff will provide three one-day community orientation sessions on the Income Assistance Policy over a three month period. It is important Income Assistance Recipients attend this session to be informed of the policy changes. At this session, the staff will ensure the required paper work for each recipient's file is completed. The paper work will include having a signed application form, two pieces of ID for adults (one piece of ID for each child), financial needs assessment, bank statement, CRA tax assessment, medical documents, maintenance orders, court orders, pay stubs, tenancy agreement, declaration of residency in Nelson House. Stay tuned for further community notices on the orientation sessions.
