Electrical Contract Job # 2022-01 Noosi Muskwa Women's Shelter

- The project and requirements contained herewith shall cover all electrical services and shall include supply, delivery, commissioning and decommissioning of all equipment necessary to provide an efficient, safe and satisfactory service, meeting all Electrical Codes and Regulations.
- 2) The successful Contractor will be required to work closely with the Commercial Properties Manager, Manitoba Hydro Commercial Inspector and or his designate to co-ordinate and develop the work plan to safely execute the Contract work.
- **3)** The project is to consist of disconnection and reconnection of the primary feeder lines to the exterior distribution and 800-amp interior electrical panel.
- 4) Contractor responsible for all required permits to complete the electrical contract work.
- 5) Contractor required to do testing to be able to safely isolate equipment being disconnected or reconnected.

Contractor Responsibilities and Liabilities

- A) Contractor is required to provide a Wellness Mitigation plan which will identify which protocols your company will use at the work site for exterior and interior work. Example (an employee arrives at the worksite and is not well). What is the process you will use to mitigate possible threat of exposing illness to others on the work site? Sanitizing, masks, testing etc.
- B) Contractor responsible to maintain a safe and clean work environment.
- C) Contractor responsible to adhere to all applicable codes and regulations pertaining to the work.
- D) Contractor responsible to remove all debris from work site and haul to the landfill site or area designated by the owner, in a timely manner and not allow the debris to accumulate on site or in the property.
- E) Contractor responsible for the safety of all persons permitted on the site for the duration of the contract.
- F) Contractor responsible to inform the NCN Commercial Properties and Claims Manager of any unsafe or health hazardous conditions that may arise as the work is being performed.
- G) Any additional work that may arise from this report, will be negotiated between the contractor and the Designate appointed by the Owner.
- H) All additional work or changes to the contract amount will be supported by an approved Change Order, prior to the contractor's continuance of original contract.
- I) Contractor responsible to provide all tools, safety equipment and permits required to perform the work.
- J) Contractor will be held accountable for the actions of all their employees or any person that the contractor grants access to the Noosi Muskwa Women's Shelter facility and or property for the duration of the contract.
