Nisichawayasihk Cree Nation Assembly Protocol

To ensure a fair and orderly community meeting, the following rules have been established that provides for a constructive meeting, to help, not hinder, the business of the assembly.

- 1. The agenda and reports are merely background information presented to the assembly.
- 2. All questions and comments must be directed to the Chair. Remarks must be courteous in language and manner avoid all personalities, never allude to others with verbal attacks and name-calling. People can be asked to leave the assembly by the security provided.
- 3. To obtain the floor (or the right to speak) must be recognized by the Chair before speaking by being the first to stand when the person speaking has finished. Raising your hand means nothing, and standing while another has the floor is out of order!
- 4. No member can speak twice to the same issue.
- 5. People intoxicated will not be allowed in the assembly. People can be asked to leave the assembly by the security provided.
- 6. The NCN staff is taking registration of people in attendance at the meeting for the band's record
